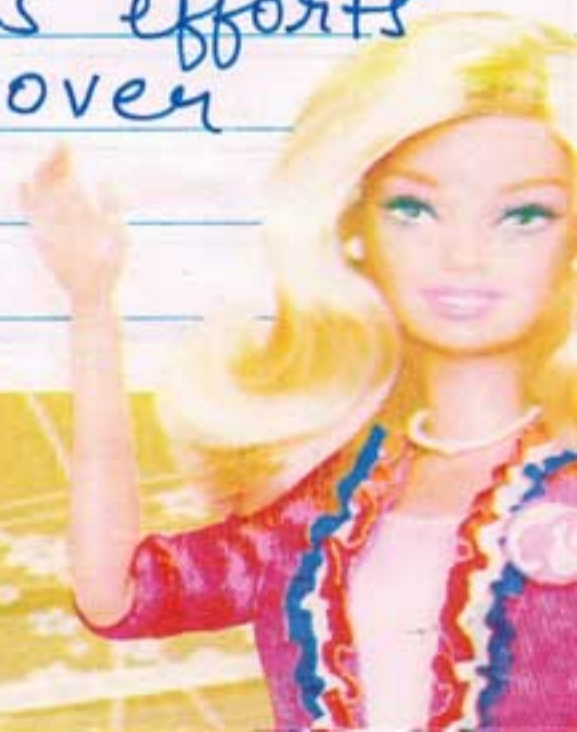


Winston Churchill

Winston Churchill was born on 30th November, 1874. He is best known for his courageous leadership as Prime Minister of UK who led the British people from the danger of defeat to victory during the Second World War.

Since then he started taking active interest in British's political life and occupying a number of important posts in the government.
