Many schools register 100% success, principals bask in rising standards

Pune: Most schools in Pune affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) recorded 100% success rate in the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (standard XII) results announced on Thursday.

The Army Public School, Khadki, recorded 100% success rate with Anushka Krishna and Barnita Basanta securing 97.8% each in humanities, Vibhu Sharma securing 97.6% in science and Saurabh Jadhav securing 96.4% in commerce to top in the school.

The Sanskriti School also registered 100% success and Aadit Deshpande emerged the school topper with 97.2%. Director and founder of the school Devyani Mungali said, "Two other students, Siddharth Mungale (93.2%) and Snehal Kaushal (88.8%) also excelled in music in their board exam year at a national competition, Anveshan, and bagged the second position where they had to compose an original song, write lyrics and perform."

Officiating principal of Army Public School, Dighi, Dnyaneshwar Shinde, said, "The school has secured 100% result. Sahil Mohite has topped the science stream with 94.4%, Khushi Sachdev topped the commerce section with 92%, while Remya R scored 91.8% to top the humanities."

Principal D Vijaya of KV number 3, 9BRD Air Force Station said the school has achieved 100% results. "Of the 115 students who appeared

for the examination, 11 students have scored above 90%."

At Delhi Public School, principal Neelam Chakrabarty, said a total of 141 students from the school appeared for the exam and all passed. Humanities student, Shubha Mukherji topped the school with 97.8%, Medha Arora topped commerce with 97.4% and Snehil Srivastava topped the school in science faculty with 96.4%.

Sharada Rao, vice principal, Orbis School, said, "Our first batch passed with flying colours and with 100% success. Himanshu Kodre scored 95.2% to top the school and science faculty."

WITH FLYING COLOURS

Global Indian International School, Chinchwad, had 81 students appearing for the exam and all passed. Mehak Johari and Madhura Gune scored 97.4% each to top the school and humanities. Principal of GG International School, Bharti Bhagwani said that 119 students (97 from science and 22 from commerce) appeared and the overall pass percentage was 97%. Drishti Peshwani scored 96.8% to top the science faculty and a total of nine students scored above 95%.

All 55 students from The Vatsalya School, Undri passed. The JSPM's Blossom Public School, Tathawade had 87 students appear for the exam and all of them passed. Science faculty student, Tejas Sable emerged school topper with 98%.

Principal of Akshara International, Sonali Balwatkar, said all 73 students passed and 35

scored above 90%. Chirag Hegde who scored 96.20% was the school's topper.

Cherian C George, principal of Kendriya Vidyalaya NDA said the results are best in humanities. "Five of the 18 students have scored above 93%," he added.

Principal of DAV Public School, CV Madhavi, said 214 students appeared for the exam from the school and all passed. Sneha Gondukupi emerged the topper in science faculty with 97.6%. Chairman of City International School Wanowrie, Maulik Dixit, said all their 195 students passed and 39 scored more than 90% marks. Shreyas Sahare scored 96.4% to emerge the topper.

At Vikhe Patil Memorial School, Mrunmayee Nerlikar scored 98% in the science stream and bagged the top spot. A total of 69 students appeared from the school and registered 100% success. From the Air Force School, Chandannagar, 25 students appeared for the exam and all passed. Poornima Sharma with 85.4% topped the school.

At the Indira National School, commerce student, Gurpreet Bhasin scored 96% to top the school. Prasad Pardeshi, principal of Indira National School, Wakad said one of his students, Karan Bellad stood third in humanities in his school, despite having learning difficulties. The Lexicon International School in Wagholi had 148 students appear from science faculty with Kashish Kanidia topping with 95.8%. About 38 students appeared from the commerce stream and the school recorded 98.9 pass percentage.
