Education-The priceless treasure an individual possesses starts formally at the age of 3. The most innocent, fresh and sensitive phase with an active mind starts at this age. The mind of a child at this age-group, acts as a sponge that absorbs each and every drop of knowledge that falls on it without any segregation. Therefore the education, knowledge and values imparted to this age group plays a vital role in determining their personality, behaviour and overall development. 
CELEBRATING NATIONALISM




Creative Minds






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
